ONBOARDING PROCESS

If your application is selected, an interview will be arranged to determine suitability. Your interviewer will discuss the placement details, your schedule as well as a few other questions.

If your application is accepted, be prepared to submit the following onboarding documents.

Detail Form

The first document to be completed is a personal details form with your emergency contact details

02

Statutory Declaration

We require a statutory declaration to be signed as per a contractual agreement with our key clients.

03

Working Rights

If you are not an Australian citizen or permanent resident, we are required to confirm working rights via passport details or a recent VEVO Check.

04

Internship Deed

The last document that we require is the Internship Placement Deed which serves as your contract. This will be sent to you prior to your start date.



PLACEMENT DETAILS

01 **Schedule**

We have designed our internship program to be as flexible and accommodating as possible. You can choose any length of placement and schedule (within the maximum limits).

A typical internship for Symbio is 11am-7pm, 3-4 days per week, for 3 months

02 **Vocational Placements**

Vocational placements have a maximum term of 456 hours total over any schedule.

A placement is vocational when the internship is a requirement of your course; will count towards course credit; or has been arranged by your institution

03 **Non-Tertiary Placements**

Non-Tertiary placements have a maximum term of 12 weeks with no more than 3 consecutive days per week.

A placement is non-tertiary when none of the previous apply; you have applied directly and; are not affiliated with any tertiary institution
